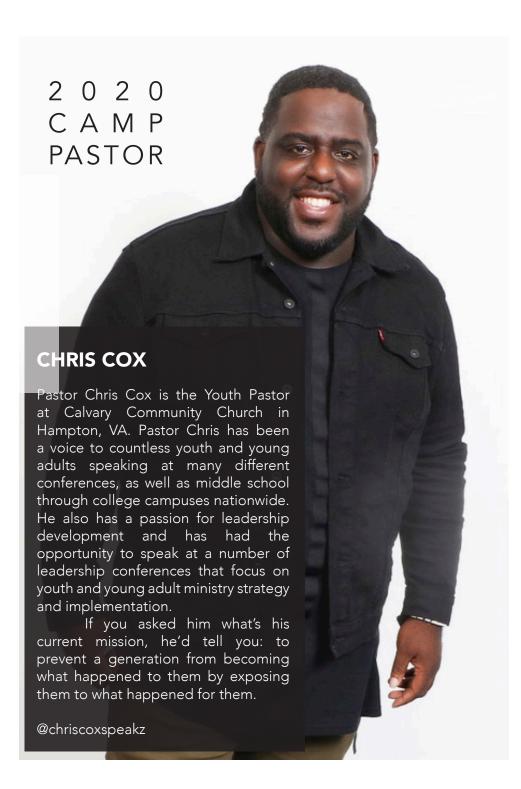


who are we?

RESET is a nonprofit organization created to push the boundaries of traditional discipleship methods to better reach inner city students and youth group leaders. Our vision is for students and leaders to build relationships, connect with Christ, and cultivate their influence.

In August 2014, the founder of RESET Camp, Pastor Chip Luter, III, had a vision to offer an alternative to traditional summer camps that was relevant to urban ministries. One year later, we launched our first summer camp. Since then, RESET has garnered attention from students, ministry leaders, and youth groups across the nation and has served more than 450 students and leaders. In March 2017, RESET Ministries was incorporated as a 501(c)3 organization. We have continued our mission by serving inner-city churches, community groups, students, youth ministries and volunteers year-round.







RESET Camp will be packed with recreation, teambuilding, worship, and biblical teaching. In order to maximize everyone's camp experience, we will be working intentionally to make sure we stick to the schedule as closely as possible. FRIDAY NIGHT REC clothes (wear a RESET shirt if you are a returning

Campers should come to morning sessions dressed in their village colors (see pg. 6). Do not be afraid to go all out (because our staff is)! Following lunch, we will head to the REC field for high ropes, bazooka ball, paintball, basketball, football, volleyball, and more!

After REC, campers will have a break and an opportunity to clean up and get dressed for the night: 70's night. Think Soul Train, Roll Bounce, Brady Bunch, etc. Parents and Group Leaders, you may have to help your kids out! Please make sure that while you are participating in the night's theme that you are still dressing appropriately for camp.

SUNDAY MORNING REC clothes/swimwear

Campers should come to morning sessions dressed in recreation clothes with swimwear underneath. We will be headed to the REC field after lunch for water rec. If you do not plan to get wet, there will be other recreation activities to participate in.

FAMILY GROUPS

are designed for groups to debrief about the day. We understand that although camp is a fun-filled experience, it is critical that family group time is set aside in the schedule. This gives leaders and students the opportunity to connect, reflect on the day, and discuss takeaways from the day's message. Each group will be assigned a RESET staffer to support the leader in facilitating.

CREATIVES

are opportunities for students to explore and cultivate their God-given gifts. RESET offers four options for students to participate in: Music, Drama, Rap/Spoken Word, and Dance. Each group will perform what they've worked on at The Showcase. Campers will also be able to sign-up as an individual talent for The Showcase.

EXPECTATIONS

CHAPERONES

Chaperones will be expected to make sure students are arriving to scheduled sessions and meals on time, and ensure that students are meeting the expectations below. The Group Leader will be contacted if a student is not present 10 minutes after the start of a session or if there is a behavior issue.

NEW CELL PHONE POLICY

Phone usage at camp is at the discretion of the Group Leader. However, throughout the weekend, some sessions will allow campers to use their phone to interact with us via games and social media. We will also be sending announcements and updates via text. Cell phone usuage will only be allowed for designated purposes. We will notify campers when we have entered a "no phone zone." Failure to comply may result in the phone being confiscated until the end of camp.

BEHAVIOR

- Participate in all scheduled services and activities
- Be on time to all scheduled services and activities
- Be respectful of your leaders, peers, and yourself
- No public displays of affection (no purpling)

SAFETY

- No guests will be allowed to rent golf carts, and may only ride in golf carts if injured
- No running on inclines
- No wet clothing inside the worship area and cafeteria

HOUSING

- Campers should be in their room by 11:30 PM with lights out no later than 12 AM
- No guys in girls' rooms and no girls in guys' rooms
- At least one adult (18 years or older) should be assigned to each room

DRESS CODE

- Wear closed toe and closed heel shoes at all times
- Wear your name tag at all times (water activities excluded)
- No clothing that advertises to tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs
- No clothing that explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred
- No clothing that explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations
- No spaghetti straps, except for sleepwear
- No clothing excessively short or tight fitting
- Please wear modest, one-piece bathing suits covered with a dark colored T-shirt
- Please wear modest shorts, dresses, slacks, and/or jeans
- Please do not dress in ways that call attention to underwear (sagging, rolled down waistbands, etc.)

IMPORTANT:

The Camp Director reserves the right to prayerfully send a camper home anytime at their discretion for any illegal and/or inapproporiate activity that takes place at camp. Group leaders will be responsible for arrangements if such takes place.

WHAT TO PACK

We encourage all attendees to dress appropriately for camp. Comfortable, modest clothing and closed toe/heel shoes. We recommend packing a few extra items in case you need to change during the day.
